


HERITAGE COUNCIL DETERMINATION

Determination Date	3 June 2021
Place/Object Name	(Rail Bridge) Albion Viaduct
Location	Keilor East and Sunshine North, Brimbank City and Moonee Valley
VHR Number	H1197
Category	Registered Place

At a meeting of the Heritage Council of Victoria on 3 June 2021 it was determined that, in accordance with s.62 of the *Heritage Act 2017*, the above place is to be amended in the Heritage Register, by making the following amendments:

- Amending the extent of registration by including additional land pursuant to s.49(1)(d)(i) and (ii), in accordance with the Executive Director’s recommendation report; and,
- Determining categories of works or activities which may be carried out in relation to the place for which a permit is not required (permit exemptions), pursuant to s.49(3) in accordance with the recommendation of the Executive Director but with the following changes:
 - Under the heading ‘Fire suppression duties’ remove the words ‘..... provided all heritage features and values of the place are identified and protected.’
 - Under the heading ‘Graffiti’ the note in para 4 should be amended to read as follows:
 - Note: Surface patina may be present on the steel and concrete and if so needs to be preserved during maintenance and cleaning.

This decision was reached having considered the information included in the Executive Director’s statement of recommendation and submissions received in response. The Heritage Council’s reasons for determining to make the above amendments to the Heritage Register are generally in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.
