

HERITAGE COUNCIL DETERMINATION

Determination Date	1 December 2022
Place Name	Yarrawonga Primary School
Location	2 Tom Street, Yarrawonga, Moira Shire

The Heritage Council of Victoria determined on 1 December 2022 that:

- the above place is not of State-level cultural heritage significance and should not be included in the Victorian Heritage Register in accordance with section 49(1)(b) of the Act; and
- the recommendation be referred to the relevant planning authorities, respectively, for consideration for an amendment to a planning scheme in accordance with section 49(1)(c) of the Act. The Heritage Council recommends that the relevant planning authorities give consideration to the historical associations of the school with the period following the end of WWI (the interwar period), including the development of elements as WWI memorials.

This decision was reached having considered the assessment against the Heritage Council's criteria, the information included in the Executive Director's statement of recommendation, and eight (8) submissions received in response. The Heritage Council's reasons for determining not to include the place in the Heritage Register are generally in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.
