

## HERITAGE COUNCIL DETERMINATION

The Heritage Council of Victoria determined on 6 April 2023 that:

- the above place is of cultural heritage significance to the State of Victoria and is to be included in the Heritage Register, as a Registered Place in accordance with section 49(1)(a) of the *Heritage Act 2017*; and
- categories of works or activities which may be carried out in relation to the place for which a permit is not required (permit exemptions) are to be included, pursuant to section 49(3) of the *Heritage Act 2017* in accordance with the Executive Director's recommendation.

At the same time, the Heritage Council resolved to recommend to the Executive Director that:

- reference be made to the 'day of mourning' in the Statement of Significance; and
- explicit reference be made in the historical information to the deputation leaving from the place, and that it mentions that this reference comes from the families' oral history of the place; and
- amendments, as set out on page 7 of the Executive Director's response to questions (dated 6 April 2023) should be made.

This decision was reached having considered the assessment against the Heritage Council's criteria and the information included in the Executive Director's statement of recommendation and submissions received in response. The Heritage Council's reasons for determining to include the place in the Heritage Register are generally in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.
