The Heritage Council of Victoria determined on **1 June 2023** that:

- the above place is of State-level cultural heritage significance and should be included in the Victorian Heritage Register as registered place in accordance with section 49(1)(a) of the *Heritage Act 2017*; and
- the categories of works or activities which may be carried out in relation to the place for which a permit is not required (permit exemptions) are to be included, pursuant to section 49(3) of the *Heritage Act 2017*, in accordance with the Executive Director's recommendation.

This decision was reached having considered the assessment against the Heritage Council's criteria and the information included in the Executive Director's statement of recommendation and submissions received in response. The Heritage Council's reasons for determining to include the place in the Heritage Register are generally in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.
