The Heritage Council of Victoria determined on 1 February 2024 that:

- the above place is of cultural heritage significance to the State of Victoria and is
 to be included in the Victorian Heritage Register ('VHR') as a Registered Place
 in accordance with section 49(1)(a) of the Heritage Act 2017 (Vic); and
- the proposed categories of works or activities which may be carried out in relation to the place for which a permit is not required ('permit exemptions') and will not harm the cultural heritage significance of the place are to be included, pursuant to section 49(3) of the *Heritage Act 2017 (Vic)*, in accordance with the Executive Director's recommendation.

This decision was reached having considered the assessment against the Heritage Council's criteria, the information included in the Executive Director's statement of recommendation and the submissions received in response to the Executive Director's recommendation. The Heritage Council's reasons for determining to include the place in the VHR are generally in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.
